


### Mout FRANCI

### The Specifications:

A family of four needs a revamp of the ground floor of their two-storey home. They would like more open-plan living, an outdoor entertainment area, a bathroom, and an office for a parent who works from home.


The stairs must stay in place.

A much more functional and open living space that flows seamlessly outside, along with a larger kitchen that is now the effective heart and center of the home. The home office is tucked behind the stairs to minimise noise, and the bathroom has been expanded to include a shower.

### The Specifications:



They want a more functional use of space, and for the kitchen to have lots of storage and counter space. They do not want an island with bar stools.


### The Result:


### The Result:



### Project 4 8 ESKDALE PLACE


### The Specifications:





